

Michael Saylor Offered Elon Musk to Buy More Bitcoin

Talking to Twitter, Founder and CEO of electric motor vehicle Elon Musk alluded to buying English football club Manchester United. The tweet caught the attention of many fans and mainstream media. This is mainly due to the club's fans being unhappy with the decisions of the current owners. When asked if he was serious, Musk said it was just a joke and would not buy a sports team. However, Musk's electric vehicle company, Tesla, has shown great interest in BTC. Last February, Tesla announced it had added \$1.5 billion BTC to its balance sheet.
